INCLEMENT WEATHER POLICY

Inclement Weather Communication Policy

- Player and coach safety is the first and last consideration with every decision regarding inclement weather. Head Start Sport will do everything possible to ensure that safety is maintained and your tennis experience is impacted as little as possible.
- Head Start Sport uses a range of tools to assess the impact and forecast of weather conditions.
- Assume all lessons are continuing unless you have received notification of cancellation by Head Start Sport.

Wet Weather Policy

- To give every lesson the best chance of going ahead, Head Start Sport will wait until 30 minutes before the scheduled start time before making a decision to cancel.
- If wet weather conditions are unsuitable for play, Head Start Sport will cancel a class and notify parents/players.
- Weather can be unpredictable, and Head Start Sport may cancel a lesson upon your arrival if conditions change and become unsuitable.
- If conditions become unsuitable once a lesson is underway, Head Start Sport will continue with the class in a safe location using a modified program.

Heat Policy

- If, at 7am on the morning of the lesson, the BOM website forecasts a maximum daily temperature for your venue (e.g. Lockleys) of:
- 38 degrees or more, all AFTERNOON (12-6pm) lessons will be cancelled.
- 40 degrees or more, ALL LESSONS will be cancelled.

Catch-Up Lessons

- If a lesson is cancelled due to inclement weather, players will be eligible for a catch-up lesson.
